This summer, the congregation is invited to participate in serving activities that will promote an Investment of Passion. Simply put, whenever we as Christians put our faith into action in helping others, especially those in great need, then we are investing our passions as well as our energies in the work of God. There is an old saving, "What the hands do, the heart learns". In other words, whenever our hands and selves become involved serving and helping, the passions of our heart become ignited and we want to do it more!

As with all the areas of emphasis listed above, there is a wonderful amount of Investment of Passion already at Muddy Creek. Social ministry, volunteering, service projects, helping at the Community Meal and many acts of kindness abound! But, as a congregation, we can develop it even more! To that end, you are invited to invest your passions in one or more of two opportunities.

The first is in the latter part of June (the exact date will be announced very soon). We have the opportunity to go as a church, and invite our friends and neighbors as well, to pack food at the GAIN Warehouse in Mt. Joy. GAIN (Global Action Network) distributes tons of food in North America and

all around the world to hungry and disadvantaged people, and we will help pack this food at the Mt. Joy warehouse. There are ways for all ages and all physical capabilities to be involved. Watch the bulletin and Facebook for the date and learn how you can be involved!

The second will be on Saturday, September 12. As part of our denomination's yearly "God's Work, Our Hands" weekend, Muddy Creek and friends are invited to participate as a group in Lancaster County United Way's "Day of Caring". Joining together with over 1,500 other volunteers from the county, our teams will be assigned to help and serve at a specific site in the county. It may involve painting a house for an elderly person, or cleaning a yard, or it could be at any one of dozens of sites!

As your hands serve in these or in any other way, we pray that your passions may continue to be ignited and invested in the work of God!




