Annual Meeting Will Be Held on May 15 Including Vote on Air Conditioning Project

On Sunday, May 15, immediately following the 10:15 a.m. service, our Annual Meeting will be held. It was rescheduled from the original date of January 30 due to CoVid. At the meeting, we will hold a vote on moving forward with the Air Conditioning Project. At the Church Council meeting in March, the Council voted to recommend to the congregation at the upcoming Annual Meeting that we commence with the Air Conditioning of the Sanctuary at a cost not to exceed \$100,000, with the money to come from the Air Conditioning Fund and the Bequest Fund. Also at the Annual Meeting, we will approve the Annual Bulletin of Reports. An advance copy of the Bulletin of Reports is available from the table under the mailboxes. Please come out for this important meeting to help us get our quorum of 40 people! Additionally, we will have a time of fellowship, coffee and refreshments following the Annual Meeting.


Ascension Service at Swamp Lutheran on May 26
